Fall Family Fun Day

North Country Community Recreation Center will welcome families and neighbors to its Fall Family Fun Day on **Saturday, September 27, from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.** at **33 Rec Center Road** in Colebrook, NH. There will be a full afternoon of activities for all ages, most offered free of charge, with donations encouraged to support the center's plan to build a new sliding hill for future family recreation. Highlights of the day include a competitive cornhole tournament (\$50 per team) with online registration and walk-ins accepted, a pickleball tournament alongside free beginner lessons, and Strong Man challenges separated into adult and children's divisions. Children will have a host of kid-focused attractions, including a bounce house, face painting, and kiddie cornhole, while caregivers can use a

dedicated baby changing and nursing tent. The Colebrook Ski Bees will be on site selling refreshments, and The Porch on Main will run a lemonade and charcuterie stand. Organizers say the event is designed not only for fun but to strengthen community ties and raise funds for projects that will expand outdoor family opportunities at the center.

"This is a great way to bring families together and celebrate the fall season," said organizers from the North Country Community Recreation Center. "It's also a chance to support future community projects, like our sliding hill."

Residents are invited to bring friends and family, register early for tournaments, and enjoy an afternoon of autumn activities aimed at building a brighter recreational future for Colebrook.
